Brunswick County, Va., has an old account book of his great-grandfather Isaac Hicks (1735-1817) of Brunswick County. Isaac Hicks was an enterprising man who ran a fleet of wagons to Petersburg, hauling goods for the Brunswick People. His account book dated 1783-1816 records all these transactions, throws a great light on commercial transportation of that time, and gives valuable genealogical material concerning the inhabitants of Brunswick.

From this book I copy the following Bible records:

Isaac Hicks was born the 19th Day of May 1735 and died June the 20th 1817.

Hancy Hicks was born the 11th day of April 1764

and died the 3d of June 1802.

Rebecca Hicks Daughter of Isaac Hicks and Nancy His wife was born Ruesday the 13th day of January in the year of our lord God 1784.

Rouben Booth Hicks son of Isaac Hicks and Mancy his wife was born the 28th day of May being a Sunday

in the year of our lord God 1786.

Thomas Hicks son of Isaac Hicks and Hancy his wife was bonr on Thursday the 10th day of Becember 1789. Elizabeth Booth Hicks daughter of Isaac Hicks and Hancy his wife was born on Sunday the 20th Hay 1792.

Sally Hicks Daughter of Isaac Hicks and Maney his wife was bonr on Friday the 9th of October 1795.

Nancy High daughter of Isaac Hicks and Nancy his wife was born the 6th day of August 1798 - died the 18th September 1804.

Minerva Hicks daughter of Isaac Hicks and Nancy

his wife was born the 10th of January 1801.

My beloved wife departed this life on the evening the 3 day of June 1802.
