 Donn                    the time she became the guardian of Catharine Donn  
                           (sic) and W.H. Donn, they were the owners of about  
 Downs                    40 acres of land which they inherited from their  
                           mother, Martha Jane Downs, but that their father -  
                           Enoch Downs - was living and had a life estate in  
 McManama            said land. Enoch Downs died in the spring of 1863  
                           and the land was then sold to O.D. McManama - the  
                           land is in Grant County on Eagle Creek - that part  
                           of the William Hicks tract of land allotted to Martha  
                           Jane Downs who was a daughter of William Hicks dec'd.
