 - 4th Should any or either of them fail to accept this will they forfeit all claim or claims to any part of my estate & their share shall go to those that do accept said will -
- None of my children shall take part in the division of said property I direct & appoint my friend W. B. Wilson Executor of my estate should he fail select some other disinterested person to settle it
