  - 2<sup>nd</sup> I then give to my daughter Maria L. Hill a note of five hundred  
and seventy dollars & being the balance of a note of N.L. Farris  
given in a division with her brother - also my <sup>Mar</sup> Peggy ~~Mar~~ Bass  
& Room furniture.
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Then to my sons Thos Hill & Wm Hill the sum of Five  
hundred dollars each part of it in their hands should there be a surplus  
divide equal
  - 4<sup>th</sup> Should any or either of them fail to accept then will they forfeit  
all claim or claims to any part of my estate & their share shall  
go to those that do accept said will.
- None of my children shall take part in the division of said property  
I direct & appoint my friend W.B. Wilson Executor of my estate  
should he fail select some other disinterested person to settle it
- This 5<sup>th</sup> day of December 1890
